- Acceptance of a student will be based on school records, a personal interview with parents and student, testing results, and/or recommendations concerning character, attitude, general promise, and spiritual development.
- CLAS is not equipped to accommodate the special needs of all children. With evaluation, review of a student's particular needs, and approval of the Administrator and teacher(s), students with exceptional physical, cognitive, language, or emotional needs may be accepted. Special needs students will be monitored and re-evaluated periodically.

Enrollment Procedure

All families wishing to enroll must fill out an application and supply enrollment documents, see below checklist, which will then be followed by an interview with the Administrator. Prior to the interview, a student may be screened or tested to help determine his/her academic level and/or emotional maturity.

The Administrator will conduct a family interview to discuss the criteria listed above. If all other factors are satisfactory (ability to pay, provision of school records, and proof of a physical), the student(s) will be enrolled in school. Parents will be notified of acceptance or rejection.



Entrance Requirements

The application will be processed on receipt of the signed contract which creates a binding application to pay all fees.

- Payment of € 1000.00 Registration Fee. (€ 500.00 of which to be paid immediately, the second payment to be added to the first invoice.)

Once we have received the paperwork, we will contact you via email as soon as it has been processed to confirm a place at the school.

Grade 1 / 2

Students for Grade 1 must be 6 by September 30th.

Also for Grade 1, participation in a Kindergarten class which has fostered basic reading, numeracy and writing skills in the child's native language is a prerequisite.

Grades 3 / 4 Mixed Class (depending on number of enrollments)

Please note: CLAS reserves the right to cancel a class or combine classes if the number of students in the class make it financially inviable. Alternatively, parents may agree to an increase in fees in order to preserve the financial viability of a particular class.



Parent Orientation and Involvement
